What is Integrated Pest Management?

Integrated Pest Management is:

- » Safer
- » More effective
- » Required by state law

Integrated Pest Management — or IPM — is an effective and safer alternative to traditional pest control methods. IPM addresses the conditions that cause pest problems and uses reliable, non-chemical and less-hazardous chemical methods to provide long-term pest control.



The video provides a practical over-view of IPM, focusing on the following topics:
